2012 has been an exciting and productive year for Carmichael Water District (CWD). A highlight of 2012 has been the "Blue Thumb Neighbors" program that has brought free river-friendly landscaping education and resources to the Carmichael Creek service area. So far, there has been an overwhelming response within the Carmichael Creek community with several homeowners participating in this exciting program.

As the meter installation program draws closer to completion, with just over 125 meters left to install, CWD looks to the future. Along with routine maintenance and regulatory compliance, future projects include water main installation and replacement, utility relocation due to the Fair Oaks Boulevard Plan, and potential water sales to neighboring agencies.
